

BAZA FESTIVAL 2026 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

**These Terms and Conditions shall apply from 1.08.2026
and govern BAZA Festival 2026 taking place on 22.08.2026.**

§1. General Provisions

1. These Terms and Conditions, hereinafter referred to as the "Terms and Conditions," set out the rules for participation in the event called **BAZA Festival 2026**, hereinafter referred to as the "Event."
2. The Event will take place on **22.08.2026** on private property, at / in the following location: **49°55'41.2"N 18°29'38.8"E**.
3. The organizer of the Event is **Stowarzyszenie Fotosyny**, ul. 1 Maja 196, Golkowice 44-341, NIP: 6472609160, REGON: 528875959, hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer."
4. The Event is an artistic and entertainment event and is ticketed. The Event is not a mass event within the meaning of the Polish Act on the Safety of Mass Events.
5. Entering the Event premises constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions and an obligation to comply with their provisions.
6. Every person present on the Event premises is required to behave in a safe and respectful manner, without disturbing the comfort of other participants, and to follow the instructions of the Organizer, staff, security, information services, emergency services and the Police.
7. These Terms and Conditions are available at **bazafestival.com/regulamin** and at the entrance to the Event premises.

§2. Event Hours

1. The Event gates will open at 17:00.
2. The official end of the Event is planned for 03:00 the following day.
3. The Organizer may temporarily suspend entry to the Event premises for safety, organizational, technical or public order reasons.
4. The Organizer reserves the right to change the gate opening hours, the end time of the Event or individual program items if justified by safety, organizational, technical or weather-related reasons, decisions of competent authorities or other circumstances beyond the Organizer's control..

§3. Tickets, Entry and Wristbands

1. Entry to the Event premises requires a valid electronic ticket purchased via the Going platform, a ticket purchased at the box office at the entrance gate on the day of the Event, or an invitation issued by the Organizer.

2. Participants are required to present their ticket or invitation in a manner allowing Event staff to verify it.
3. A ticket or invitation entitles the holder to one-time entry to the Event premises. Once the Event premises have been left, re-entry on the basis of the same ticket or invitation will not be possible.
4. The Organizer shall not be liable for tickets purchased outside the official sales channel, i.e. outside the Going platform or another channel expressly indicated by the Organizer.
5. The Organizer may refuse entry if a ticket is illegible, has already been used, cannot be verified or raises justified doubts as to its authenticity.
6. Upon entry, a participant may receive a wristband or another marking confirming their right to remain on the Event premises.
7. Removal, damage, loss, transfer or making the wristband available to another person may result in the participant no longer being allowed to continue participating in the Event.
8. A ticket purchased at the box office at the entrance gate on the day of the Event is not eligible for refund or exchange, except in cases resulting from mandatory provisions of law, in particular if the Event is cancelled by the Organizer.
9. Complaints concerning ticket purchase, payment or operation of the sales system should be submitted in accordance with the rules of the Going platform.

§4. Entry Control

1. The Organizer or Event staff may ask a participant to present their ticket, invitation, proof of age, or the contents of a bag or backpack to the extent necessary to ensure safety and verify compliance with these Terms and Conditions.
2. Refusal to cooperate with the above-mentioned procedures may result in refusal of entry to the Event premises.
3. The Organizer may refuse entry to or remove from the Event premises any person who:
 - is visibly under the influence of alcohol, narcotics or other similar substances,
 - behaves aggressively, provocatively or in a manner threatening the safety of others,
 - possesses items prohibited by these Terms and Conditions,
 - refuses to follow the instructions of the Organizer, staff, security or services,
 - breaches the provisions of these Terms and Conditions.
4. Removal of a participant from the Event premises due to a breach of these Terms and Conditions does not entitle them to a refund of the ticket price.

§5. Minors

5. Persons aged 16 or over but under 18 may attend the festival independently, without the presence of a parent, legal guardian, or other caregiver. Persons under the age of 16 may attend the festival only if accompanied by a parent, legal guardian, or an adult caregiver holding written authorization from the parent or legal guardian.
6. The written authorization referred to above must remain available throughout the event and must be presented upon every request of the Organizer, security staff, or event staff, both at the entrance to the festival grounds and during the event.
7. The Organizer, security staff, and event staff are entitled to verify the participant's age and the authority of the person supervising the minor. If the required written authorization is not presented, or if there are reasonable doubts as to whether proper supervision over the minor is being exercised, the Organizer has the right to refuse entry to the festival grounds or require the participant to leave the event area.
8. The Organizer recommends that parents and caregivers carefully consider whether the participation of young children in the festival is appropriate, taking into account the nature of the event, the number of attendees, the noise level, and the conditions at the festival grounds.

§6. Safety and Public Order Rules

1. Participants are required to behave in a manner that does not endanger the safety of others and to respect the Event premises, the Organizer's property, the property of other participants and neighboring areas.
2. In particular, the following are prohibited:
 - physical or verbal violence,
 - threatening other participants, staff or representatives of the Organizer,
 - damaging property, infrastructure, signage, fences, decorations, technical equipment or elements of the premises,
 - entering areas inaccessible to participants,
 - blocking evacuation routes, entrances, exits, communication routes and technical access roads,
 - throwing any objects,
 - lighting fires outside clearly designated areas,
 - relieving oneself outside toilets,
 - taking any actions that may disrupt the Event or endanger participants.
3. Participants are required to dispose of waste in designated bins and maintain order on the Event premises.

4. In the event of danger, an alarm, evacuation or any other extraordinary situation, participants are required to remain calm and follow the instructions of the Organizer, staff, security, emergency services and the Police..

§7.

Permitted and Prohibited Items

1. The following may be brought onto the Event premises:
 - a phone, documents, wallet, keys and other small personal items,
 - a small handbag, waist bag or small backpack with dimensions not exceeding [maximum size to be confirmed – volume may also be specified],
 - one factory-sealed PET bottle of water up to 0.5 l per person,
 - medicines and products necessary for health reasons.
2. In particular, the following are prohibited on the Event premises:
 - weapons, ammunition, knives, sharp tools and other dangerous items,
 - explosive, pyrotechnic, flammable or fire-hazardous materials,
 - narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and other similar substances,
 - personal alcohol,
 - glass bottles, cans and other dangerous packaging,
 - laser pointers,
 - gases, corrosive, irritating, staining or other hazardous substances,
 - items which, due to their characteristics, size or intended use, may endanger participants or disrupt the Event.
3. The Organizer may refuse to allow an item onto the Event premises if there is a justified suspicion that it may be used in a manner endangering the safety, order or comfort of other participants.
4. In the case of prohibited items, the Organizer may refuse entry to the Event premises or request that the participant leave the item outside the Event premises. The Organizer does not operate a deposit or storage facility for personal belongings.

§8.

Alcohol, Food, Beverages and Payments

1. Bringing personal alcohol onto the Event premises is prohibited.
2. Consumption of alcohol purchased on the Event premises is permitted in accordance with applicable law and the rules set by the Organizer and the entities conducting sales.
3. Bringing personal food and beverages is prohibited, except for one factory-sealed PET bottle of water up to 0.5 l per person and products or medicines necessary for health reasons.
4. Available payment methods on the Event premises are payment card and cash. Availability of specific payment methods may depend on the individual sales point.

§9.
Cigarettes and E-Cigarettes

1. Smoking traditional cigarettes and using electronic cigarettes is permitted only in designated areas.
2. Participants using designated smoking areas are required to observe fire safety rules, maintain order and respect the comfort of other participants.

§10.
Deposit, Cloakroom and Personal Belongings

1. There will be no deposit or cloakroom available on the Event premises.
2. The Organizer does not store participants' belongings and shall not be liable for items left unattended, lost, damaged or stolen, subject to mandatory provisions of law.
3. Lost items will be stored at the Lost & Found point at the main gate on the day of the Event, and after the Event for a period of 7 days.
4. After 7 days, the Organizer may handle the items in accordance with applicable law.

§11.
Animals

1. Bringing animals onto the Event premises is prohibited.
2. This prohibition does not apply to assistance dogs accompanying persons with disabilities, in accordance with applicable law.

§12.
Photo, Video, Drones and Event Recording

1. Taking amateur photos and recordings with a phone for private use is permitted, provided that it does not disturb the comfort of other participants or interfere with the Event.
2. Professional photo/video recording, commercial live streaming, use of professional equipment and use of drones require the Organizer's prior consent.
3. The Organizer may refuse entry of equipment intended for professional image or sound recording if the participant does not have the Organizer's consent.

§13.
Participant Image Rights

1. The Event may be photographed and filmed by the Organizer or persons acting on the Organizer's behalf.
2. The participant acknowledges that their image may be recorded and disseminated as part of Event coverage, promotional, informational, documentary or archival materials of the Organizer, in particular on the website, social media and video materials.

3. A participant's image will not be used in a manner infringing their personal rights or as the main subject of commercial material without separate consent, unless otherwise provided by law.

§14.

Programme, Artists and Timetable

1. The Organizer reserves the right to make changes to the programme, schedule, order of performances and artistic line-up if such changes result from organizational, technical, safety-related reasons, circumstances beyond the Organizer's control or artist availability.
2. A change in the programme, order of performances, performance times or individual artists shall not constitute grounds for a ticket refund, provided that the Event takes place in accordance with its main character.

§15.

Event Cancellation, Changes and Force Majeure

1. The Organizer reserves the right to make changes to the course of the Event, in particular resulting from technical, organizational, safety-related reasons, decisions of competent authorities, weather conditions or force majeure.
2. Force majeure shall mean an external event beyond the Organizer's control that could not have been foreseen or prevented, in particular extreme weather conditions, decisions of public authorities, technical failures, power outages, safety threats or other events making it impossible to hold the Event as planned.
3. If the Event is cancelled, the Organizer will inform participants about ticket refund rules via the website, the Organizer's communication channels or the Going platform.
4. Detailed rules regarding refunds and complaints related to ticket sales are set out in the Going platform regulations, subject to mandatory consumer protection laws.

§16.

Parking and Access

1. Parking of vehicles is permitted only in places designated by the Organizer or the land manager.
2. Blocking access roads, evacuation routes, gates, entrances, technical access routes and private property of third parties is prohibited.
3. Vehicles left in a manner that obstructs emergency access, blocks passage or endangers safety may be removed at the owner's expense in accordance with applicable law.

§17.

Open-Air Nature of the Event and Noise

1. The Event takes place outdoors. Participants should adapt their clothing and footwear to the weather conditions and the nature of the terrain.
2. The Organizer recommends bringing comfortable footwear and weather-appropriate clothing, including waterproof clothing in the event of unfavorable forecasts.
3. The participant acknowledges that they may be present in an area of elevated sound levels during the Event.

4. The Organizer recommends the use of hearing protection, especially for persons sensitive to noise.

§18.

Commercial, Promotional and Advertising Activities

1. Without the Organizer's consent, it is prohibited to conduct sales, promotional campaigns, collections, distribution of advertising materials, agitation, surveys or any other commercial activity on the Event premises.
2. The name, logo and visual identity of the Event are protected. Their use for commercial, promotional or advertising purposes requires the Organizer's prior consent.
3. Only the Organizer may grant the status of sponsor, partner or patron of the Event.

§19.

Persons with Disabilities and Special Needs

1. Persons with disabilities or special organizational needs are requested to contact the Organizer in advance at: kontakt@bazafestival.com, so that information regarding the accessibility of the Event premises can be provided.
2. The Organizer will make reasonable efforts to provide participants with information regarding participation conditions, accessibility of the premises and entry arrangements.

§20.

Personal Data

1. Participants' personal data are processed in accordance with applicable law and the Privacy Policy available at bazafestival.com.
2. If tickets are sold via the Going platform, the personal data processing rules specified by Going shall also apply.

§21.

Final Provisions

1. A breach of these Terms and Conditions may result in refusal of entry, removal from the Event premises without the right to a ticket refund and, in justified cases, referral of the matter to the relevant authorities.
2. In matters not regulated by these Terms and Conditions, applicable provisions of Polish law shall apply.
3. The Organizer reserves the right to update these Terms and Conditions if justified by organizational, safety-related, technical reasons or changes in applicable law. The current version of these Terms and Conditions is available at bazafestival.com/regulamin
